MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT : PD FROM 16 MAY 2022 TO 15 JUN 2022

1. <u>Elimination of Identified Single Use Plastic</u>. A concrete program was being organised for classes I - XII to make the students aware of the hazards of plastic consumption in their daily life and how they can contribute at their level to save Mother Earth. To express their concern and to do little things to preserve our Earth a number of beautiful and innovative activities such as writing, calligraphy, poster making, extempore, pottery ,plastic free kitchen, article writing, speech, catchy mantra", E-Card, E- Poster, E- Brochure etc were organised.



2. **Summer Camp**. The Summer camp was conducted in Army Public School, Jhansi from 12th May to 21st May for children to learn new skills in a safe and nurturing environment and to engage them in activities that they find both enjoyable and meaningful. Around 450 students participated in different activities under two categories i.e. Club A & Club B.
