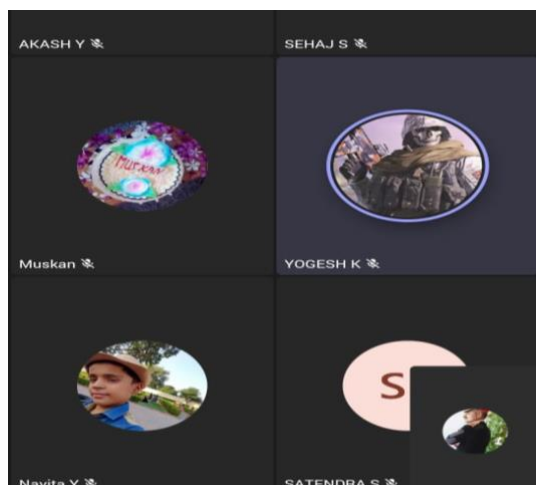


MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT : PERIOD FROM 16 JUN 2021 to 15 JUL 2021

1. **JESSICA PETERS PROMOTIONAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE GIRL CHILD.** On the onset of the academic year, Mrs Sheeba Peters establishes a scholarship scheme as a tribute to Army Public School, Jhansi. Every year, one girl child who has been promoted from class 9 to class 10 and the one who meets the criteria set under the scheme will be awarded with a cash prize of Rs 7500/-. Ms Anjali Pandit D/O Sub Sohendra Pandit, of class 10A has aptly met the given criteria and therefore has been awarded with the scholarship.

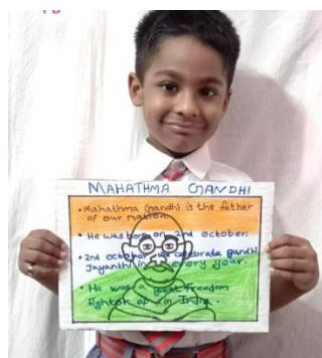

4. **COMPUTER FEST : 1 JUNE TO 28 JUNE 2021.** Computer Fest for classes 1st to 12th was organized from 1st June to 28th June 2021. All the students of classes 1 to 12 participated in the activities as per their talent and choice. The activities for 'Computer Fest' were as follows:-

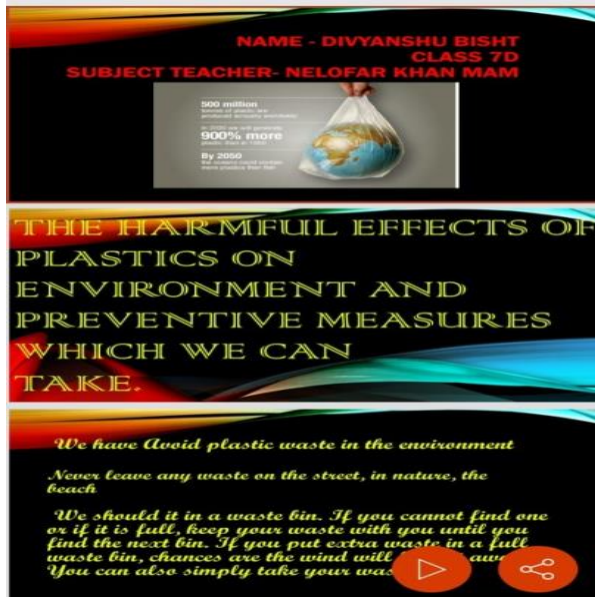

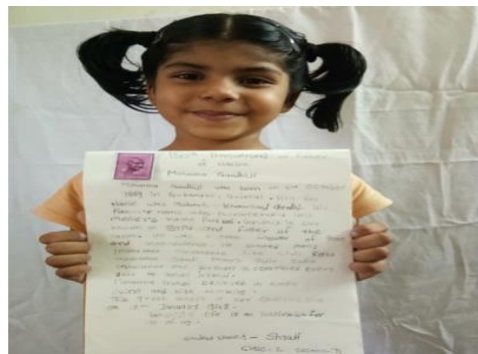

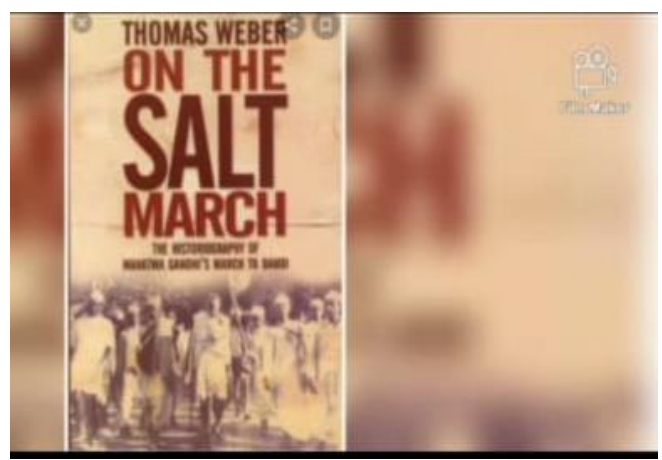
21. POWERPOINT PRESENTATION ON MAHATMA GANDHI'S BIOGRAPHY.

Students of classes 6th to 8th were asked to make PPTs on 'Life Style of Mahatma Gandhi'. They sent their PPTs to their respective class teachers.



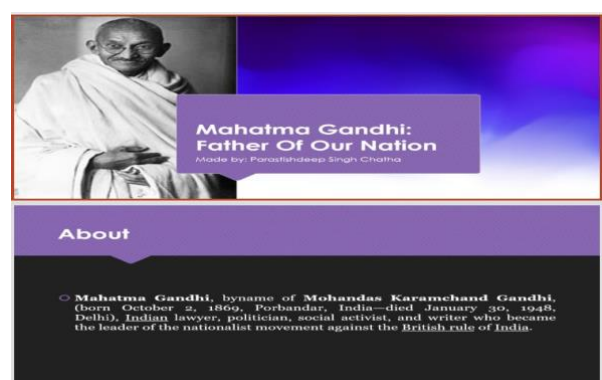
22. VIDEO MAKING USING DIFFERENT APPLICATIONS.
