MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT: PERIOD FROM 16 AUG 2021 to 15 SEP 2021

1. **<u>Principals' Conclave</u>**. A Principals' Conclave for all the (APS) Principals of Southern Command was conducted from 31 Aug 21 to 01 Sep 21 by APS Kirkee Pune. Mrs Meenakshi Panjwani, Principal along with Mr Naushad Khan, Vice Principal, APS Jhansi witnessed this conclave. The main speaker Mrs Roopa Arun, DB Area, threw light on Streamline Online Education, Implementation of NEP 2020 followed by Effective Lesson planning, Assessments, Worksheet and Bloom's Taxonomy. It proved to be an interactive and a wonderful session.



2. <u>Command Principals' Meet</u>. The annual meeting for Chairmen, Principals and SOs of Army Public Schools of HQ Southern Command was held on 6 September 2021 virtually at Army Public School Kirkee. 22. <u>**Clock Making**</u>. The tiny tots of classes 3 to 5 drew creative clocks and came up with amazing ideas using different types of waste materials.




23. <u>Say No To Plastic</u>. Students of classes 1-5 made an activity that aimed at bringing about a general awareness in students regarding use of plastic.



30. **Fraction Bird**. Students of classes 1-5 prepared activities that enabled them to play and experiment with shapes, symmetry, fractions , colours etc.




31. <u>Tricolour Pattern</u>. Students from classes 6 to 12 displayed their great efforts by creating interesting drawings in tri-colour.

33. Model of Clock.- Students of classes 9 to 12 made wonderful models of clock.




34. **Salad Decoration**: Students of classes 9 to 12 were asked to make tri coloured salad.




