

## MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT: PERIOD FROM 21 AUG 20 TO 20 SEP 20

1. **28 August 2020 : Declaration of Result for UT-1 (Classes 3 to10 & 12).** Online result was prepared and uploaded in digicamp and the link of the same was shared with the parents to see the result of their ward.
2. **29 August 2020 : PTM for Classes 3 to 10 & 12.** An online PTM for classes 3 to 10 & 12 was conducted on 29 August 2020 on Microsoft Teams to apprise the parents about the results as well as the progress of their wards .
3. **29 August 2020 : PTM for Classes 1, 2 & 11.** An online PTM was conducted for classes 1, 2 & 11. Parents of the students of classes of 1 & 2 were apprised regarding the upcoming EV-1 whereas the parents of the 11<sup>th</sup>std students were informed about the UT-1.
4. **Eva-1 for Classes 1 & 2.** Online Eva-1 for classes I &II was successfully conducted online via Google form with a planned time table from 9 Sept to 12 Sept 2020.
5. **26 August 2020.** An activity based on the theme '**Reduce, Reuse and Recycle**' was conducted for classes 6 to 8 on 26 August 2020. The activities under theme were :-

- (a) **Leaf Family (For Class 6).** In this activity students were asked to search leaves of various shapes & sizes and create people, animals or other figures of their choice.
